High Altitude Sickness Awareness

Colorado Springs altitude is 6,008 feet above sea level. Please drink plenty of water 3-5 days prior to arrival.

It is hard to determine who will be affected by altitude sickness, as there are no specific factors that compare with this susceptibility to altitude sickness. However, most people can climb up to 8,000ft above sea level normally.

It is recommended to talk with your health care professional if you have any health concerns about traveling to high altitude.

If you have plans to travel to Colorado's beautiful mountains, it is also recommended to allow at least 24 hours stay in Colorado Springs before traveling to the Colorado high country. Colorado is home to 54 mountain peaks that summit over 14,000 feet above sea level.

Prevention:

- As alcohol tends to dehydrate, avoidance in the first 24 hours at higher altitude is optimal.
- Avoid strenuous activities in the first 24 hrs
- Drinking plenty of water will also help in acclimatization to replace fluids lost through heavier breathing in the thin, dry air found at altitude.

Symptoms:

Slight headaches are common followed by one or more of the following:

- Lack of appetite, nausea or vomiting
- Fatigue or weakness
- Dizziness or light-headedness
- Shortness of breath upon exertion
- Drowsiness
